Career advisement services may be provided to individuals of any age. They are intended to assist individuals make informed educational and/or occupational choices. Services are structured according to the needs of the individual and may include one or more of the following areas:

- Completion of a clinical interview.
- Assessment of vocational interests and work values.
- Assessment of aptitudes and general learning potential.
- Introduction to career planning techniques and resources.
- Introduction to educational, occupational, and/or labor market information and resources.
- Job seeking skills and advisement.
- Job accommodation advisement.
